

2024 Training and Show Fees

Training and Board: \$1500/month

Blanketing: \$50/month

Lesson rate/hour: \$70 private and \$60 group

Shoeing: Varies per horse \$110-\$350

Sale Commission: 10%

Hauling: \$.75/mile plus a fuel surcharge split between horses in the trailer.

Minimum hauling fee of \$125

Show Fees

Hauling: \$.75/mile round trip (see above)

Day fees: \$75/day horses in training \$125/day for horses not in training

\$125/day World Show and Congress show days (Day fees start on departure

day and end on return day home)

Non owned horse usage fee: \$50/day

EXPENSES TO BE REIMBURSED

Tack Room: Spilt between horses/varies with each show

Medications: Bute, Banamine, or Dex \$15. Adequan \$65. Legend \$90.

Summit \$35.

Banding/Braiding: \$40-\$65/\$55-100 (varies between shows)

Stall fee and shavings: Varies with each show

Sponsorship: Split between owners/varies with each show

Expenses: Split between each owner. Expenses include hotel, food

(\$45/day/TPH trainer/groom), grooming supplies, and clipping.

Futurity/World show prize money (open horses only): Owner and Open

rider split prize money 70/30 after entry fees are paid.

*Training includes 2 lessons per week on the horse in training. Additional lessons and/or lessons on another horse are \$70/lesson. Training includes deworming every 90 days.
